### Context

- In Victoria all school aged children have a **designated neighbourhood government school**.
- Some schools will have a **designated neighbourhood school boundary**.
- The **deemed neighbourhood school** is defined as the nearest school to the student’s permanent address.
- Government expectations are (if children are being schooled in the government system) that they attend this neighbourhood school.
- Each school has a government determined student capacity number.
- When that capacity number is reached enforcement of a **neighbourhood boundary policy** may be applied.
- The **neighbourhood boundary** is not always permanent and may be in existence or not depending on the current enrolment and the government determined enrolment capacity of the school.
- Procedures, policies and actions at every school manage enrolments and, must ensure that children who live in the **school neighbourhood area** have access to a place at their **neighbourhood school** at any time of the year that a request is made.
- If not at capacity schools, will consider enrolment requests from parents outside of their **designated neighbourhood area**.
- There is a set school process for this which includes providing the opportunity to fill in an expression of interest form – available upon request from the office.
- Any offers for places for families living outside of the neighbourhood area, cannot be confirmed until Semester two.
